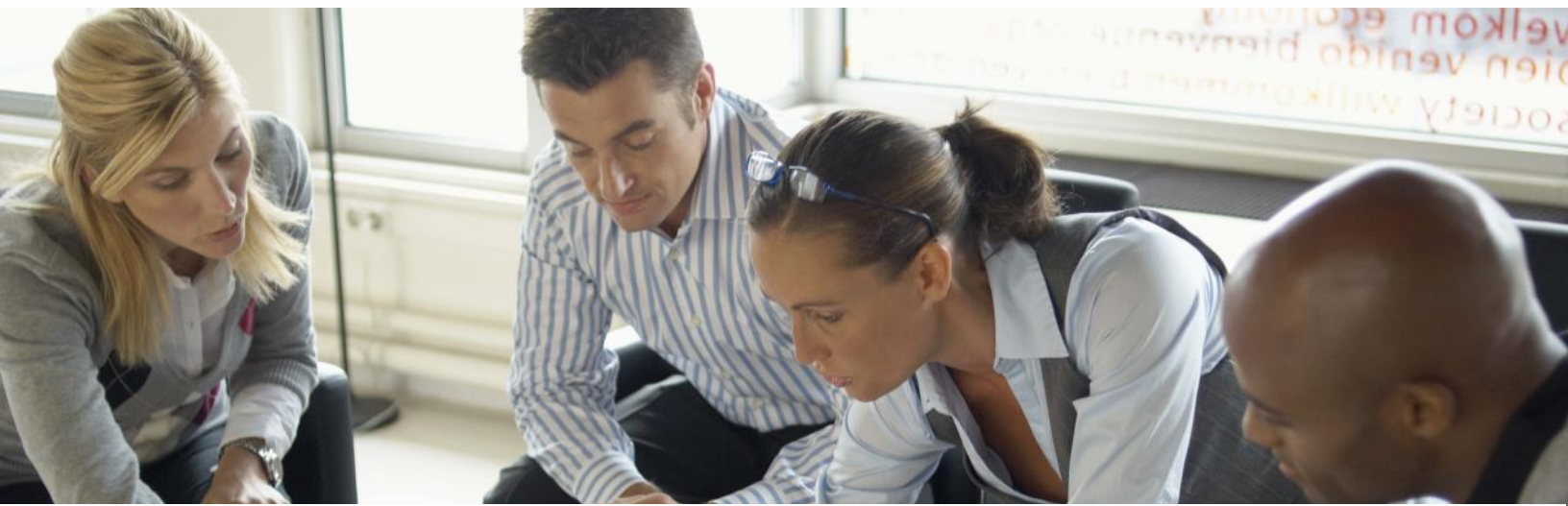

##### CPR - Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation

The goal of the BLS for Healthcare Providers Workshop is to train participants to save lives of victims in cardiac arrest through high-quality cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). The American Heart Association designed the BLS for Healthcare Providers Workshop to prepare healthcare professionals to know how to perform CPR in both in- and out-of-hospital settings. This workshop trains participants to promptly recognize cardiac arrest, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations, and provide early use of an automated external defibrillator (AED), as part of a team and individually. This workshop also teaches how to relieve choking. The workshop includes adult, child, and infant rescue techniques.

##### CPR - First Aid / Heart Saver

Heart saver CPR / AED is a comprehensive workshop for the first responder and is designed to teach adult, child and infant CPR, use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction (FBAO) to those who are expected to respond to emergencies in the workplace. It is specifically designed for lay rescuers who are required to obtain a course completion card (a credential) documenting completion of a CPR / AED course. This workshop is appropriate for lay people who are interested in basic life support for adults, children and infants.
