Stay safe during Trick or Treat with these tips:

Plan a route in advance and walk safely using traffic signals and crosswalks, wear light colors and reflective lights with costumes

Make sure all costumes are well-fitting and avoid masks so that you do not have blocked vision, or invite trips or falls

Have children accompanied by a responsible adult, tell children not to eat treats until they return home so you can check your child's candy, and teach your children not to enter a stranger's home
