## **New Polling Place Locations Announced for Four Voting Precincts** *Election Day is Tuesday, November 6 – Polls Are Open from 7 AM to 8 PM*

**PITTSBURGH** – The Elections Division today announced that four additional voting precincts have been moved because the former voting place had no heat or is going through mold remediation. Those locations include Penn Hills 8-2, Pittsburgh 12-14, Pittsburgh 12-15 and Pittsburgh 12-16. The new polling locations follow and are also included in the full list at the bottom of this release:

Impacted voters have been sent letters advising them of the change, and postings will be made on the former polling place locations on Election Day to direct voters to the new sites.

Election Day is this coming Tuesday, November 6, 2018. Polling places open at 7 AM and are open continuously through 8 PM. Anyone in line to vote at 8 PM will be allowed to vote before the polling place closes. Anyone having issues at their polling place should speak to the elections officials at the polling place and, if unresolved, should contact Elections at 412-350-4500.

The Elections Division also reminds residents that they may verify their voter registration, look up their polling place and view a sample ballot online at the county's "[On Election Day](#)" webpage. Of particular note, there is a proposed county Home Rule Charter amendment question on all ballots in the county. Additionally, three municipalities also have questions on the ballot in those municipalities for this election. Bethel Park has four questions, Monroeville five, and West Deer four questions. Voters in those municipalities are encouraged to review their sample ballot to view the questions, as well as the explanation for each, prior to election day.
